DETAILS OF WORK

On January 8, 1951, we ran 764' of 8-5/8" 144 new seamless casing and gradded with 25 sacks of Aquagel. This casing was run to shut off a dry casing section. We expected to pull this casing when the production string was run since no water was encountered. However, when we started to pull this pipe, it was stuck very tight and we left all of it in the hole.
