DETAILS OF WORK

On 6-1-50, we ran 3676' of new 7" O.D. 30# 5ml. casing and cemented with 300 sac. Mud preceded the cement and was circulated to the surface. After allowing the cement to set 72 hours, plug was drilled and water was swabbed out and the drilling was resumed.

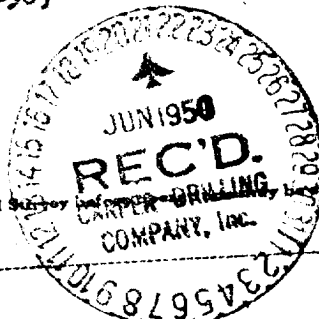
