DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; size of casing, weights, and nature of proposed casing; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

On 4-22, we ran 975' of 8-5/8" 21.5 lb/ft. casing and cemented with 50 sac by Halliburton. Well was making 1/2 to 1 barrel of water from 680-890. Top of salt was encountered at 942'. After allowing the cement to set 48 hours, the plug was drilled, hole bailed down and no water appeared in the hole. Drilling was resumed.

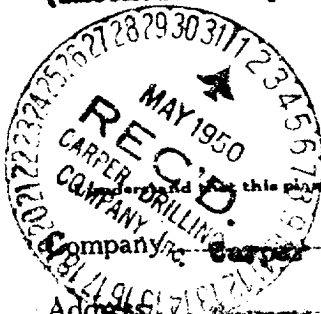
