Dear Mr. Gafford:

According to the provisions of Division Order WFX 647, the above referenced well has been reclassified from a salt water disposal well to an injection well in the Mesa Queen Unit.

According to our records, we had requested, in a letter to Mr. Capps dated June 2, 1993, that you submit a sundry notice giving the following information:

- 1> Any repairs to the wellbore necessary to bring the well into a satisfactory condition for use as a salt water disposal (injection) well.
- 2> Tubing size.
- 3> Packer setting depth.
- 4> Date of first injection into this well.

To date, no report has been received and all of the above information is necessary to complete our records for both injection and salt water disposal wells.


Also, an attempt was made to conduct an annulus pressure test on this well on September 10, 1993. The information indicates a possible casing leak. You were requested by letter dated September 13, 1993, to shut in the well until repairs are made and approved.

All of the these items are still applicable, and we request that you comply with these requests.

Since you are already showing the injected volumes and pressures for this well for the Monthly Production Report (C-115), no change is necessary in reporting.
