This well was projected to be a 5,800' San Andres test but has been temporarily abandoned at a total depth of 277'. There was 273' of 13-3/8" OD 8rd. 48# casing run and cement was circulated with 125 sacks.

As evidenced by the attached letter of agreement this well will be converted to a water well by Mr. C. W. Hillard of Lovington, New Mexico. Mr. Hillard agrees to assume the operation of this well and the responsibility for plugging, if required when the well is to be permanently abandoned.

NOTE: There has been no attempt to salvage 13-3/8" casing because of the circulation of cement.

Instructions

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to the Federal "TH" #1 well which was projected as a 5,800 foot San Andres oil test. This well has been temporarily abandoned upon reaching a total depth of 277'. There was 275' of 13-3/8" OD 8rd. 48# casing run and cement was circulated with 125 sacks. This casing was run to obtain a water shut-off of the only surface water strata encountered in drilling to the total depth of 277'.

It is our intention to abandon this location permanently but we have been approached by the owner of the surface who wishes to convert this well to a water well.

It is therefore agreed and understood that Mr. Clayton H. Hester of Lovington, New Mexico will relieve John H. Trigg of any and all responsibility for the future operations on this well. It is further understood and agreed that Mr. Gene A. Snow will accept full responsibility for the final plugging of said well and will comply with procedures and regulations of the United States Geological Survey or any other state regulatory body, if required when the well is to be permanently abandoned.

Having entered this agreement, John H. Trigg respectfully requests to be relieved of any responsibility for the future operation of this well.
