

DETAILS OF WORK

I plan to drill a 3800' San Andres test with combination tools.

We will spud with cable tools and set 150' of 13 3/8" surface casing with sufficient cement to circulate.

We plan to set 8 3/8" intermediate casing in the top of the Anhydrite at approximately 2100' with 300 sacks.

We will run a 4 1/2" oil string on any pay and cement with 200 sacks.

All casing will be run and cemented under methods approved by the U.S.G.S.

* Cement on 4 1/2" to cover all zones of porosity below salt section.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.


