- Operator pulled rods, pump and tubing from Kemnitz zone.
- Drilled out bridge plug at 11,050' and cleaned out to 13,790' tubing tally for completion attempt from Morrow-Atoka section. Displaced w/KCL water.
- Perforated Morrow 13,636-43' (7'), 13,677-83' (6'), 13,692-94' (2'), 13,720-31' (11') and 13,758-62' (4'). Perforated Atoka 13,035-40' (5'), 13,043-50' (7') and 13,070-76' (6').
- Set packer at 13,586' w/14,000# compression. Treated Morrow perms 13,636-13,762' w/6000 gallons Morrow flow and displaced w/KCL water. Dropped 50 ball sealers in groups of 10. Max TP 6600, average TP 6300. Average IR 3.43 BPM. ISIP 5600#, 5 min. SIP 5600# 10 min. SIP 5600#.
- Swabbed acid water, load water, mud and sand and swabbed dry w/very slight show of gas. Determined that 5½" casing was parted at 13,609'.
- Set CIBP at 13,140' above Morrow perms. Dumped 35' cement on top of CIBP.
- Set packer at 12,863' and treated Atoka perms 13,035-13,076' w/3500 gallons Morrow flow. Used 50 ball sealers. Displaced w/KCL water. Max TP 6400#, average TP 6000# at 6 BPM. Recovered all load and swabbed 15-16 BW per hour. No show of oil or gas. Recovered 78.1 bbls over load.
- Set CIBP at 11,080' above Atoka perms. Dumped 35' of cement on top of CIBP. Set CIBP at 11,060' above Seaman perms. Dumped 35' of cement on top of CIBP.
- Returned to production from Kemnitz perms 10,770-10,831'.
