Gentlemen:

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Continental Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval, in exception to Rule 4 of the Special Pool Rules for the Baish=Wolfcamp and Maljamar=Abo Pools contained in Order Nos. R=2765 and R=2766, for an unorthodox location 1730 feet from the North line and 460 feet from the West line of Section 22, Township 17 South, Range 32 East, Lea County, New Mexico for its Baish "A" Well No: 13, as provided in Rule 5 of the same orders.

In support of this request we respectfully submit the following:

1. Applicant is the owner and operator of the Baish "A" lease, comprising W/2, NE/4 and N/2 SE/4 of Section 21 and W/2 NW/4 Section 22, T=17S, R=32E.

2. Applicant drilled and completed its No. 13 well on said lease as a producer in the Baish-Wolfcamp and Maljamar-Abo Pools, as authorized by Order MC=1551, at a location 1780 feet from the North line and 460 feet from the West line of said section 22.

3. Said well was moved 200 feet North and 200 feet West of the standard location in order to avoid interference with applicant's Baish "A" No. 2, a temporarily abandoned Maljamar producer located 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line of said section 22. 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4. Said location is removed a greater distance from the center of the quarter-quarter section than is permitted by Rule 4 of the Special Pool Rules contained in Order Nos. R-2765 and R-2766.

5. The attached plat shows to the best of our knowledge and belief the area surrounding said well, the location of leases and wells and the ownership thereof. As shown thereon, applicant owns all offsetting leaseholds.

6. The granting of this application is in the interest of preventing waste and protecting correlative rights.

In view of the facts set forth herein it is respectfully requested that the Secretary-Director approve the non-standard location described above occasioned by the topographic obstruction of a pre-existing well.
