Gentlemen:

Tri-Service Drilling Company assumed operations of the T. P. State well No. 1 located in Unit J, 1887' from the east line and 2164' from the south line, Section 1, T-16-S, R-38-E, Lea County, New Mexico at July 5, 1968. The well had been drilled to a total depth of 13,014' and plugged in conformance with Conservation Commission rules.

Tri-Service plans to re-enter the well and clean out to a depth of approximately 11,570' and deviate the hole to a location approximately 300' east and 300' south of the surface location at an estimated total depth of 13,000'. We propose to commence operations on this well within the next week and understand that we proceed at our own risk.

We respectfully request that this matter be placed on your docket for hearing as soon as possible.
