17. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations (Clearly state all pertinent details, and give pertinent dates, including estimated date of starting any proposed work) SEE RULE 1103.
- (1.) 8-5/8" csg collapsed at 2095' on 2-20-78 on trip at 5090'. Sweaged out to 7-7/8" and continued to drill.
 - (2.) Well blew out at 12,615' on 3-23-78 after cutting 10' break 12,600-12,610'. Shale from uphole heaved in and bridged around bit, drill collars and drill pipe in annulus. Mixed 12# mud w/LCM and tried to pump in. Plugged bit. Pulled 60' off bottom and stuck. Perf DP at 12,052 & 12,055' but could not break circulation.
 - (3.) Backed off at 10,680' on 3-25-78. Ran 1 1/2" tbg inside fish and cleaned out to 12,225'. Washed over and recovered 1102' of DP, crossover sub and 3 DC's between 4-1-78 and 4-17-78.
 - (4.) Twisted off washpipe 4-17-78 leaving 6 jts of 7 1/2" washpipe and shoe, one 6 1/2" DC, 13 5-3/4" DC's, junk basket, bit sub and 7-7/8" bit in hole with top of fish at 12,159'.
 - (5.) Operator will set 150' cement plug above top of fish, let cement cure, dress off plug, set whipstock and kick off with no directional control and then continue to drill to original objective.
 - (6.) Operator notified OCC by telephone of plans to by-pass fish 4-17-78.
