Dear Mr. Sexton:

The absolute open flow test on our Anderson 3 Com Well No. 1, located 1830' FSL & 1980' FEL, Section 3, T-16-S, R-32-E, Lea County, New Mexico was due on March 16, 1980. Subject well was connected to sales on January 16, 1980. By mid February, Natural Gas Pipeline of America's pipeline pressure had increased to approximately 600 psi. Subject well ceased flowing due to rapid pressure depletion and died on February 25, 1980. Attempts to swab the well back to flowing were unsuccessful. Amoco is now negotiating release from our contract with Natural Gas Pipeline of America and negotiating with Conoco for a low pressure connection. The absolute open flow test will be conducted after connection to Conoco and after a stabilized rate of flow is obtained.
