Gentlemen:

Chevron U.S.A. Inc. respectfully requests administrative approval to dispose of salt water down the subject well into a porous formation not productive of hydrocarbons in this area. Produced salt water from the North Anderson Ranch Wolfcamp and Cisco Canyon Formations will be disposed of in the San Andres Formation which occurs in this wellbore from approximately 5070 feet to 5260 feet. Disposal will be through internally plastic coated tubing beneath a packer set at approximately 5000 feet.

The following information is submitted in support of this request:

1. Oil Conservation Division Form C108 with supporting data;
2. Affidavit of publication in newspaper with county-wide circulation;
3. Location plat outlining the subject well's $\frac{1}{2}$ mile radius of review;
4. Log of the subject well;
5. Listing of names and addresses of the offset operators.
