SUBJECT: CREATION OF A NEW POOL AND ASSIGNMENT OF DISCOVERY ALLOWABLE

Gentlemen:

Upon completion, your Dickinson Cattle Company 33 Well #1-N located in Section 33, T14S, R38E, Lea County, New Mexico, was placed in the East Denton Wolfcamp Pool. However, after reviewing your supportive data it was determined to be a different reservoir and a new pool should be created.


In accordance with Division Order No. R-7048, effective September 1, 1982, the POLLOCK WOLFCAMP POOL was created and your Dickinson Cattle Company 33 Well #1 should be moved from the East Denton Wolfcamp Pool to the new POLLOCK WOLFCAMP POOL.

Further, this well has been assigned a discovery allowable of 46,910 barrels to be produced over a 2-year period.

Please amend your records to show this change in pool designation.
