

Dear Mr. Stogner:

In accordance with our telephone conversation of April 17, 1990, this letter constitutes a formal request on behalf of Anadarko Petroleum Corporation for administrative approval of a change in the unorthodox surface location granted after notice and hearing, under the above captioned case and order numbers.

The original unorthodox surface location was necessitated by the existence of a circular irrigation system. When Anadarko staked the location it was discovered that the requested location is only 36.6 feet from the end of the rattail of the circular sprinkler. We suspect that the surface owner may have added another length of pipe to the system.


We request that the Division approve an unorthodox surface location of up to 100 feet to the southwest of the present unorthodox location. The bottomhole location will remain the same.

The exhibits submitted by Anadarko at the hearing will support this request.
