Indrex, Inc. hereby makes application to directionally drill the referenced well. The surface location of the proposed well would be 660' from the West line and 784' from the South line; with the bottom hole location at 660' from the West line and 330' from the South line (reference attached plat). A directional survey of the entire well bore will be performed and provided per Rule 111.

The surface location at 330' from the South line and 660' from the West line is not a satisfactory drillsite due to the proximity of the dwellings in the area.

There are no operations of proration or spacing units offsetting the unit for which the permit to deviate is sought per Indrex, Inc records.

This application is being filed per New Mexico Oil Conservation Division Rule 111 in triplicate along with a site map for the referenced well. A copy of Oil Conservation form C-101 is also enclosed.
