Dear Mr. Hughes:

Reference is made to your application dated May 25, 1993 for a non-standard oil well location for the purpose of completing an efficient production/injection pattern within the Zapata-Maljamar Waterflood Western State Project Area, established by Division Order Nos. R-2157 and R-2157-A.

It is our understanding that the proposed Phillips "B" State Well No. 16 is to be drilled 1305 feet from the North line and 1335 feet from the East line (Unit B) of Section 19, Township 17 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Maljamar Grayburg-San Andres Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

The NW/4 NE/4 of said Section 19 shall be dedicated to said well forming a standard 40acre oil spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F(I), the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
