Unit J, Section 17 17S 33E

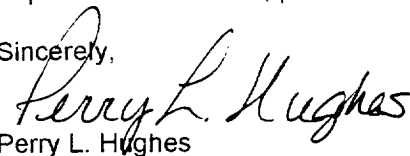
Caprock Maljamar Unit #195

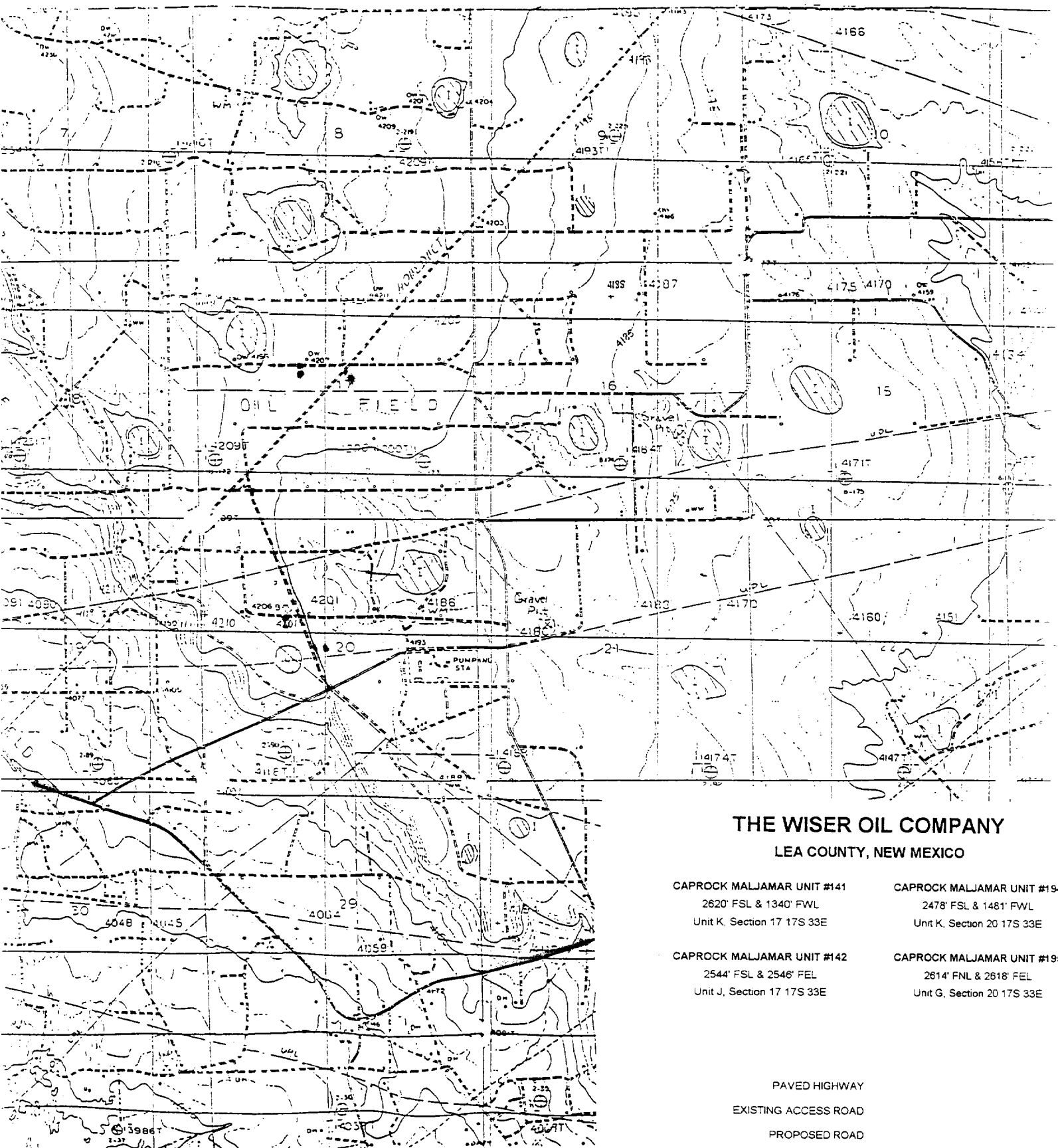

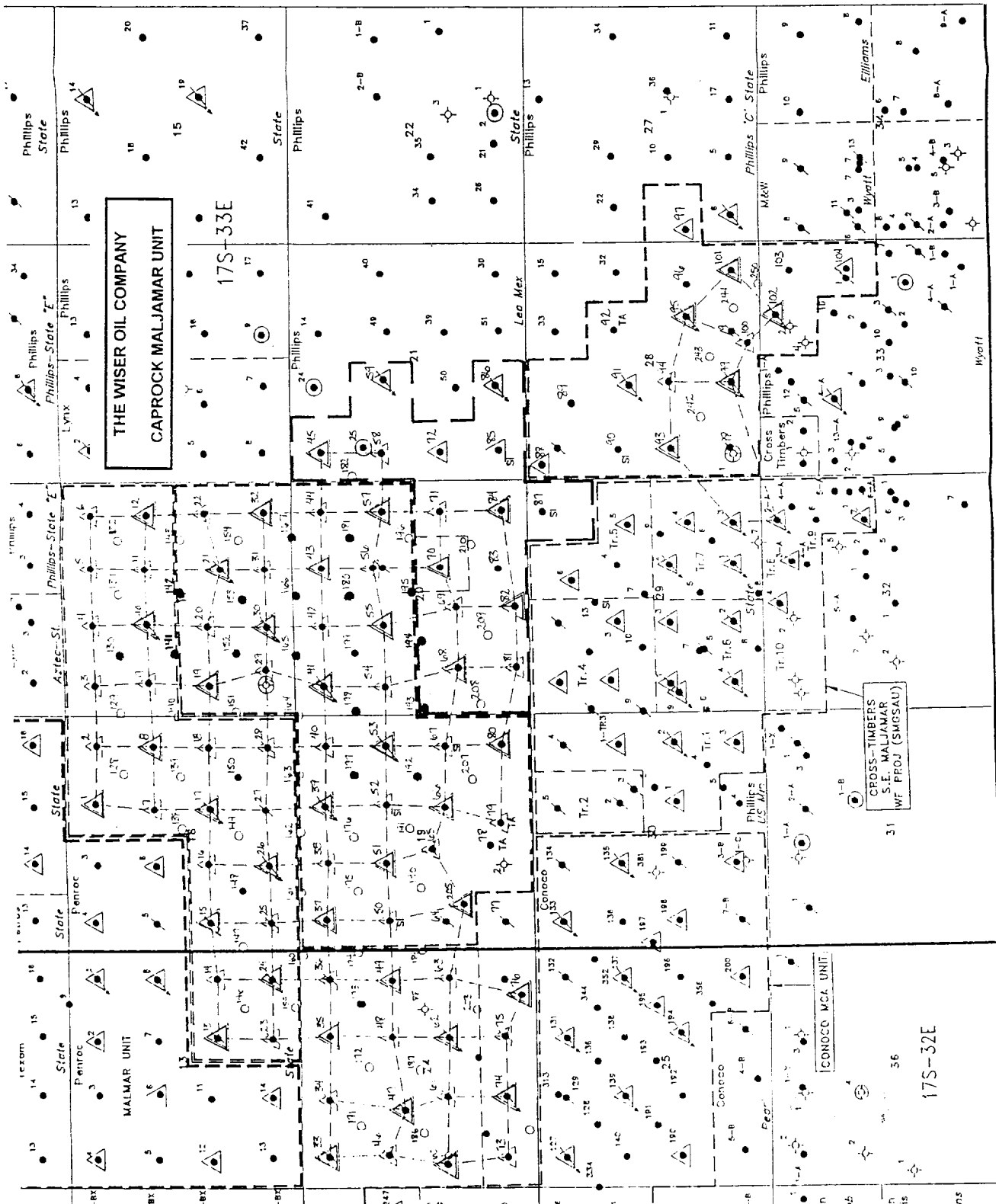
