SUBJECT: Division Order R-9722-C and R-10448-A

Gentlemen:

According to the provisions of Division Order R-9722-C and R-10448-A effective March 1, 1997, your Baer Well No. located in Unit O of Section 32, Township 15 South, Range 35 East, Lea County, New Mexico, previously placed in the West Lovington-Strawn Pool is reclassified as producing from the South Big Dog-Strawn Pool.

Pool Code: 96690

Pursuant to paragraph 4 of the order, we request that you submit a new C-104 for the above listed well.

Special rules are assigned to the South Big-Dog-Strawn Pool which include the following:

1. A standard proration unit to be 80 acres, consisting of the N/2, S/2, E/2, or the W/2 of a governmental quarter section.
2. Each well to be located no closer than 330 feet to the boundary of quarter/quarter section, nor closer than 1020 feet to a well producing from the same pool.
3. A depth bracket allowable of 445 barrels of oil per day is assigned to a standard proration unit.

Please amend your records to show this change in pool designation and notify your transporters of this change.

Further, under this same order, an allowable of 250 barrels of oil per day is assigned to the West Lovington-Strawn Pool.
