The above-named company is hereby authorized to commingle Baish-Cisco (Oil - 4471), Maljamar-Strawn (Oil -50350), West Maljamar-Devonian (96662) and **Undesignated Baish-Wolfcamp (Oil - 4480)** Pool production from the following leases:

Lease: Elvis Wells No.1 and 4 (Federal Lease No.LC-029405-A)
Description: N/2 of Section 20, and,

Lease: Elvis Well No.2 (Federal Lease No.LC-029405-B)
Description: W/2, W/2 E/2 of Section 17, and,

Lease: Elvis Well No.3 (Federal Lease No.LC-060329)
Description: E/2 E/2 of Section 17,

all in Township 17 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

Production shall be allocated to each lease by separately metering the production from each well prior to commingling

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 309-B of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

REMARKS: The commingled production shall be stored in the Elvis Consolidated tank battery facility located in Unit Letter 'F' of Section 20, Township 17 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Hobbs District Office of the Division upon implementation of the commingling process.

PROVIDING: Validation of this authority shall be accomplished with like approval by the U.S. Bureau of Land Management.
