DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Drilled 12 1/2" hole to 2186' on March 15, 1955. Ran 67 jts of 9 5/8" O.D. 32.3# H-40 casing. Total of 2174.02' set at 2186.02'. Halliburton cemented with 500 sacks of Lone Star Portland cement with 3% gel and 300 sacks of Lone Star Regular neat cement. Plug down at 1 PM March 16 1955. Cement circulated. Pressure bled back to 500#. WOC 24 hours. Started drilling cement at 1 PM March 17, 1955. Hit top of hard cement at 2139'. Drilled plug at 2149.33'. Finished drilling plug at 3:15 PM March 17, 1955.
