## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Drilled 6 3/4" hole to total depth 2100' at 6:40 AM 5-25-55. Ran 50 joints of 4 1/2" 9.5# J-55 casing. Total 1788.42' set at 1796.32'. Halliburton cemented with 250 sacks of Longhorn Portland cement with 4% gel and 100 sacks of Longhorn Portland neat cement with 1% calcium chloride per sack. Plug down at 3:20 PM 5-25-56. WOC 12 hrs. Tested 4 1/2" casing for 30 minutes OK with 1000#. Drilled cement plug and cleaned out to TD 2100'. Prep to run injection test. Rig released at 4 PM 5-26-55.
