Dear Mrs. Bell:

Regarding your letter of the 26th, in regard to the well Record on John S. Williams, Williams # 1 Well in Sec. 31, T. 17S, R. 33E, Maljamar Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, the well was drilled in 1943, with Rotary tools to the depth of 1500', we have been unable to locate a log of the well to that depth.

However, I talked with Justin Newman, with Oil Conservation here, and he suggested that I make a log on the well from 1500' to total depth of 4328', which I have taken care of. Evidently in 1943 when the well was owned by Williams Oil Company, and it being on Patented Land, they were under the impression that they did not have to file a log on the well, and one was never sent in.

I am enclosing the Well Record with this letter, hoping that this meets with the approval of your office.
