This well was completed December 16, 1959 at a PBD of 8652'. TD was 10,015' and 5 1/2' casing set @ 9001' w/1195 sac cement. Well was perforated originally from 8652' to 8582' and acidized w/250 gals. MCA and 5000 gals. 15% NEFe.

February 4, 1964 a bridge plug was set @ 8515' and well was perf. 8465-72' and 8478-8508' w/2 jets per ft. and acidized w/500 gals. 15% NEFe and 4500 gals. NEFe retarded acid. Well flowed 115 bbis. per day.

We propose to add perforations as follows and acidize w/15,000 gallons acid: one shot per interval @ 8419', 8433', 8438' and 8446'.

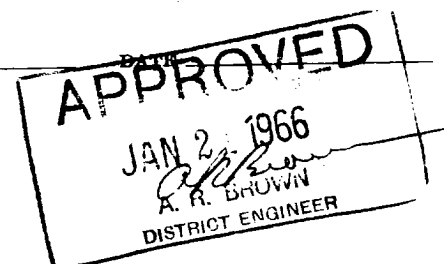

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
