DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On the above well we received permission to set the 7" O.D. casing.

Same was set at 4663', using 50 sacks of cement, setting it on the shoulder, the cement was allowed to set 72 hours and then drilled the plug, testing for the water shut-off on the upper formations, same being satisfactory. International Cementers doing the cementing. Continued drilling to 5200'. Holding drilling operations until results are obtained from our Wyatt #1 wildcat well in Section 33, Lea County.
