On the above well we intend to run approximately 4625' of 7" O.D. casing cementing same with 50 sacks of cement as we anticipate setting 5" casing, at which time we will report on running the 5". The S.L.M. as to the total depth of the well is 4659'. After all water shut-off tests have been made we will make reports on same. The International Cementers are doing the cement work.
