Dear Sir:

On May 24, 1984, Phillips representatives met with Mr. Jerry Sexton in Hobbs to discuss the "problem wells" listed in the subject order. The following is a summary of that discussion.

Mexco-A

Phillips will attempt to re-enter and plug Phillips Lexco State Well No. 2 and Cockburn Trimble Well No. 1.

Wyatt-A Federal

Phillips will attempt to re-enter and plug Cockburn Federal Well No. 1.

Phillips will monitor the 5 1/2"-8 7/8" annulus on Eilliams Well Nos. 2, 4 and 6 and will squeeze the San Andres as required.

The NMOCDD district office in Hobbs will contact Energy Reserves and have them repair and/or monitor the San Andres in Denius Federal Well Nos. 2 and 3 as required.

Since re-entry and replugging the subject wells may take several months, Phillips requests permission to commence water injection immediately. Re-entry and re-plugging operations will begin as soon as the appropriate approvals are obtained and will be completed prior to the flood front arriving at the subject wells.
