## DETAILS OF WORK

Cemented 8-5/8" (24 & 32#) casing at 1594', in two stages. First stage 250 sacks 40% DD (1050 cu. ft.) followed by 350 sacks regular; second stage, through stage collar at 1513', with 300 sacks regular cement. 100 21 hours. Tested casing for 30 minutes, no pressure loss with 1500#. Checked top of cement at 1100'.
