

DETAILS OF WORK

In reply to your letter of September 27th, 1963, wish to advise that this well was drilled by Barney Cockburn and completed as a producer in the Grayburg formation in May 1954.

In October 1956 a pilot water flood of the Queen formation was started and permission was granted to inject water into the Queen formation thru perforations at 3750 to 3768 feet and continue producing oil from the lower formations.

Water flood was temporarily abandoned April 1st 1963 and at that date 492, 580 barrels water had been injected.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
