6-10-44 TD 4765 - Lime - Dry hole, no oil or gas, 3000 feet of water in hole. Will plug and abandon. Will load with heavy rotary mud, place 20 sack cement plug from 4620 to 4720, another 20 sack cement plug from 4466 to 4566' to seal casing seat at 4516'. Will shoot off 5 1/2" OD casing at approximately 3500' pull and place 20 sack cement plug at 1528, base of 8 5/8" OD surface casing, mud hole to surface and cap cellar with 10 sacks cement and erect proper 4 inch pipe marker to designate plugged well.
