We propose to drill well with drilling equipment as follows: Marshall, Sears & Smith  
of Artesia, New Mexico with rotary to top of producing zone, run 5 1/2" casing and drill in  
with cable tools.

The status of a bond for this well in conformance with Rule 39 of the General Rules and Regulations of the Commission is as follows: Blanket Bond

We propose to use the following strings of casing and to land or cement them as indicated:

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil and gas sand should occur at a depth of about 4050 feet.

Additional information: Intend to drill to an approximate depth of 5000' to test all formations.  
Best prospects for production are considered to be in Greyburg formation at about 4600'  
with additional prospects in the underlying San Andres. If lower formation unproductive  
will plug back and complete in upper formation.
