Gentlemen:

We respectfully request administrative approval of our proposal to substitute Philmex Well No. 6 - Unit M, 27, 17-S, 33-E, for Philmex Well No. 5 - Unit N, 27, 17-S, 33-E, Lea County, to serve as a water injection well in the captioned project which was approved by New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-3668. Copies of our request for waivers—and the waivers—from offset operators are attached in support of this request. Also enclosed is a completion schematic and electric log on No. 6 and an area plat.

Initiation of the Philmex flood project has been delayed several years pending obtainment of an adequate water supply. Sufficient produced water from Phillips' area properties now exists to proceed with this program.

Subsequent to the approval of Well No. 5 for injection service, Well No. 6 went to 100% water production and was shut down. Well No. 6 is offset by water injection to the north and west. Conversion of Well No. 6 would eliminate loss of current production from Well No. 5 and yield an earlier flood response.

We respectfully request your waiver of objections to the proposal to substitute Philmex Well No. 6—Unit M, 27, 17-S, 33-E, for the Philmex Well No. 5—Unit N, 27, 17-S, 33-E, Lea County, to serve as a water injection well in the captioned project which was approved by N.M.O.C.C. Order No. R-3668. Further, we request your waiver of a hearing on our formal request for this change in designated injection wells when it is presented to the New Mexico Oil Conservation. Our records show you to be the only operators offsetting the proposed Philmex Water-flood Project, Maljamar Grayburg San Andres Pool.

Initiation of this project has been delayed for several years pending obtainment of an adequate water supply. Sufficient produced water from Phillips' properties in the area now exists to proceed with this injection project. Subsequent to the approval of Well No. 5 for water injection, Well No. 6 went to 100% water production and was shut down. Well No. 6 is offset by water injection to the north and west. Conversion of Well No. 6 would eliminate loss of current production from Well No. 5 and yield an earlier flood response.

The attached schematic reflects the proposed completion of Well No. 6. We also attached a plat of the Philmex and offset lease area.
