

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Well was shot Nov. 1, 1943 with 300 qts. of nitro-glycerin, the top being 4200 feet & bottom 4300 feet, using 3 qts of nitro-glycerin to the foot. After the well was cleaned out to the bottom same was put on a ten hour test - testing 23 barrels per hour.

Well is now producing approximately 20 bbls. per day.

Application is made to set bridge at 4140' and shoot pay zone from 4080' to 4115' with nitro-glycerin, using 5" or 5½" shells - well to be shot this date.
