**TD 4320 Lime:** Dumped gravel to 4240. Ran 460 quarts SNG as follows: 110 quarts in 3" tin shells 4240-4165. 270 quarts 4165-4115; 80 quarts in 3" tin shells 4115-4064. Gravel 4064-4050. 14 sacks Calseal 4050-3975. Bolshevik cave catchers 4060 & 4165. AG Double Action Time Bomb set to explode 2:10 PM. Shot exploded on time. Cleaned out, ran tubing, swabbed 69 barrels 14 hours.
