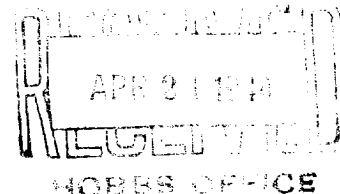

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

TD 1228 - Anhydrite - 56 joints, 1214', of 8 5/8" OD 32# L. W. casing was run and cemented on February 18 with 550 sacks common cement and 5 sacks aquagel. Plug was not drilled nor casing tested until April 12th, due to the tearing down of rotary tools at total depth 1228, and rigging up cable tools to complete drilling the well. Cement plug was drilled with cable tools and casing tested satisfactorily on April 12th.
