DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED


TD4272' Bridged hole from 4123 to 4105 with 11 feet gravel and 6 feet Calseal. Ran 124 joints (4032') 7-inch OD 24# 8 round thread H-40 SS casing and cemented with 300 sacks common cement. W.O.C. 72 hrs. Bailed casing down. Stood 2 hours. Test O.K. Shot interval from 4260 to 4317' with 220 quarts nitroglycerine in 5-inch shell. Ten-foot blank filled with gravel from 4311 to 4327'. Tamped with 55 feet gravel.


