FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

Well now producing through perforations at 5062-5084' and 5370-90'. A cement plug is set at 5450' in the 5½-inch casing. 7-inch casing extends from surface to 4364' with 5½-inch liner from 4100' to 5475'; cement returned behind the 5½-inch up into the 7-inch at 4100'. Temperature survey shows cement behind 7-inch at 3690'. 7-inch will be pulled above 3675' (approx.); 20 sack cement plug will be set at 4200' in the 5½-inch; 10 sack plug in the 7-inch below 3700'; and 10 sack plug in the top of 8-5/8 inch surface casing. (Surface casing is set at 300' and circulated.)
