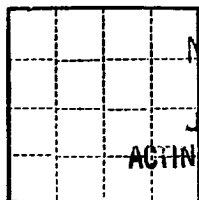

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

October 28, 1963 - Pull rods and tubing. Old TD 4378. Dumped 2700 lb. of 20/40 mesh frac sand to obtain 200' of fillup. Pressure tested plug @ 4160 with 3000 psi for 15 minutes. Perforated Lower Yates 3506 - 3514 and 3544-46 w/2JSPF.

October 29, 1963 - Ran 3500' of 2-3/8" KUE 8rd. tubing with Haliburton RTTS packer set at 3500'. Spotted 500 gal mud acid over perfs and broke down. Pulled tubing and sand-oil fractured with 16,000 gal. lease crude plus 35,000 lb. of sand.

October 30 and 31, 1963 - Swab load oil back.

November 1, 1963 - Ran 3485' of 2-3/8" KUE tubing and put well to pumping.

November 3, 1963 - Pumped 41 barrels new oil plus 7 barrels water in 24 hours.
