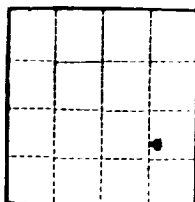

DETAILS OF WORK

In accordance with verbal approval of the USGS we set a ten-sack cement plug at 4501 to 4570 feet, filled the hole to 2000 feet; set a 10-sack cement plug at 2000 to 2745 feet, filled the hole to 1600 feet and set a 10-sack cement plug at 1600 to 1560 feet, filled the hole with mud and set a cement plug and marker at the surface. We cleaned the location and left the ground in its original condition.
