DETAILS OF WORK

Drilling commenced Oct. 27, 1955, completed Dec. 4, 1955.
 The above described well was plugged and abandoned as a dry hole on 12-5-55, leaving 300' of 8 5/8" surface casing (200') in the hole. The following cement plugs were set at the following depths:

- 20 sack plug @ 4600'
- 20 sack plug @ 3000'
- 20 sack plug @ 300'
- 20 sack plug @ top.
