

Following is a notice of intention to do certain work as described below at the Wood River Oil & Refining Co., Miller State Well No. 3 in SE 1/4 of Sec. 4, T. 17S, R. 34E, N. M. P. M., Vacuum Field, Lea County.

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We cemented 5 1/2" 17# casing two feet off bottom at 4685' with 100 sacks of 2% aquagel cement. Plug was pumped down at 5:00 A.M. August 29, 1948.

We propose to allow cement a set time of 72 hours then drill plug with cable tools, bail hole dry and test for a casing shut off.
