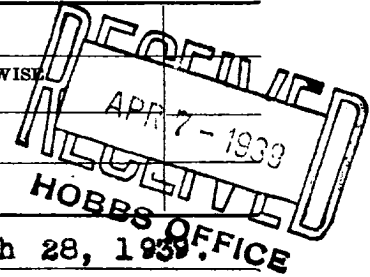

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

TD- 5015' - March 28, 1939- Ran 2 1/2" UE Tubing to bottom.

March 29th - Loaded hole with 7 ton of mud and pumped in 100 sacks cement WOC

March 31st - 7" OD Casing set @ 4545', filled bottom of hole and up into 7" OD casing 100' with cement. Shot 7" OD Csg. off @ 3100' & pulled.

April 1st - loaded hole w/ 4 ton more of mud. Shot 9 5/8" OD Casing off @ 300'. Ran tubing to 300' and set cement plug w/ 20 sacks WOC

April 3rd - Pulled 9 5/8" OD Casing and finished mudding hole to bottom of cellar. Set cement plug w/ 5 sacks in bottom of cellar with piece of 4" pipe extending 4' above surface level as regulation Marker, Filled cellar level
