DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total depth - 4680' Line.

This well was acidized on 11-22-38 with 1000 gallons of Dowell XXW acid. Before acidizing the well produced approximately 4 barrels oil per hour swabbing. After acidizing the well produced 5.44 barrels oil per hour swabbing. After re-acidizing on 11-25-38 with 2000 gallons of Dowell XX acid, the well produced 43 barrels oil in 8 hours swabbing and showed a slight increase in gas. After a third treatment with 4000 gallons Dowell acid on 11-26-38, the well produced 8.16 barrels oil in 2 hours flowing. This last test was made after running tubing with 9 Merla flow ~~valves~~ valves. Prior to running the flow valves the well swabbed 8 bbls/hr.
