T. D. - 4700' - Lime.

On a 24 hour swabbing test, this well produced 43 bbls. of oil and a very small amount of gas. We, therefore, desire permission to shoot this well from approximately from 4670' to 4700' with approximately 110 quarts solidified nitroglycerine in an attempt to increase the productive ability of this well and possibly increase the gas to the extent that the well will flow.
