

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK  
FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We request permission to use a central tank battery to receive the production from the following wells: State of N. M. "L" (Lease No. 55391) Wells Nos. 1, 2, 3, & 4; and State of N. M. "M" (Lease No. 54474) Wells Nos. 1, 2, 3, & 4; all of these wells are located on Lieu Land.

The central tank battery would, therefore, be used to receive the production from 8 wells located in the N $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 1, T-18-S, R-34-E, and would be located approximately in the center of the N $\frac{1}{2}$  of this Section as shown on the attached sketch. It would include adequate tankage and other equipment, so that the production from each well could be accurately determined at reasonable intervals.

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
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SKETCH OF THE PROPOSED CENTRALIZED TANK BATTERY FOR THE STATE OF NEW
