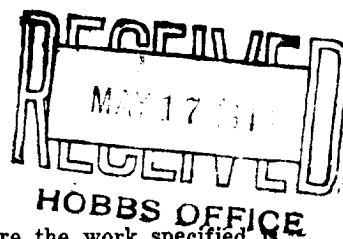

Set and cemented 1523' (73 jts) 8-5/8" 28# Lapweld Casing @ 1538' with 200 sacks cement on bottom. Ran 150' of 1" pipe behind casing and circulated with 100 sacks cement. Completed cementing 3:20 PM 5-15-40.

Anticipate drilling plug and testing casing by pressure method after 60 hours.
