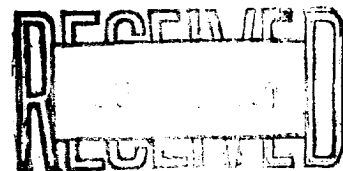

Set and cemented 1544' (73 jts.) of 8-5/8" OD, 32# lapweld casing at 1556' with 200 sacks on bottom. Ran 140' of 1" tubing behind casing and circulated with 100 sacks of cement at top. Completed cementing at 10:00 A.M., 6/10/40.

Anticipate drilling plug and testing casing by pressure method after approximately 60 hrs.
