FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

In order to ;increase production we propose to do the following work:

1. Pump well down and inject a mixture of 55 gals of cheplex in 500 gals of 5% hydrochloric acid down the tubing-casing annulus.
2. After a 24 hour period pull rods and tubing.
3. Clean out to total depth if necessary.
4. Fracture open hole section from 4189' to 4700' in 3 stages down 3" tubing with a hook wall packer set at 4145', each stage to be 10,000 gals of refined oil carrying one pound of sand per gal with 1000 lbs of flaked naphthalene between stages.
5. Recover lead oil, test, and return well to production
