DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On October 26th we set 1658' of 8-5/8" casing, 28#, circulated with bulk cement, using 500 sacks, from top to bottom. Work was done by Halliburton. Shut down for 72 hours and drilled plug. Tested pipe; hole tested dry and drilling was resumed.
