FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

This well was drilled to a total depth of 9,198' into the Bone Springs Formation. 13-3/8" O.D. casing was set at 364.28, cemented with 325 sacks cement. Cement circulated. 8-5/8" OD casing was set at 4,971', cemented with 700 sacks 50/50 Posmix-Incor cement, 100 sacks Neat. Top cement at 2990'. No productive formations were found in this well.

On 9-24-62 verbal permission was given by Mr. G. F. Engbrecht to plug and abandon this well as follows: 35 sacks cement from 8898-8762', 25 sacks 8510-8413'; 25 sacks 6700-6603', 35 sacks 5020-4923', and a Baker Model "N" C.I. bridge plug set in 8-5/8" OD casing at 3500'. An attempt will be made to recover a possible 2900' of 8-5/8" OD casing after which a 35 sack plug will be spotted at point of separation, and 35 sacks at bottom of 13-3/8" OD casing with 10 sacks in the top. A steel plate will be welded on top of 13-3/8" OD casing and a 4" steel marker installed on top of the sealed casing.
