Humble Oil and Refining Company respectfully requests administrative approval to dual complete its New Mexico State "BO" No. 1, Vacuum Abo Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, located in Unit H, Section 12, T-18-S, R-34-E.

This is a proposed multicompletion (combination) whereby one string of 4-1/2-inch casing and one string of 2-7/8-inch casing will be run and cemented in a common well bore. The Abo pay will be produced through the 4-1/2-inch string, which will be tubed with 2-3/8-inch tubing, and the Drinkard pay will be produced through the 2-7/8-inch string.
